Accepted

Medicine from households will be accepted, including:

- ✓ Prescription medicines including Schedule II-V controlled substances (such as Vicodin, Percocet, and Ritalin)
- ✓ Over-the-counter medicines
- ✓ Pet medicines

Guidelines

- ! Bring medicines in their original containers
- ! No ID required
- ! Free

Drop Box Location

Drive up service provided, no need to park your car. Look for signs directing you where to go.

Not Accepted

- ✗ No illegal drugs (Schedule I)
- ✗ No needles, sharps, or syringes
- ✗ No medicines from businesses
- ✗ No batteries, trash, medical devices, mercury thermometers, or other hazardous materials
- ✗ No cosmetics and personal care products

Proper Disposal is Important

- ! Prescription drug abuse is a growing problem, especially among teens.
- ! Accidental poisonings from medicines are also on the rise.
- ! Medicines flushed down the drain or disposed of in the trash can contaminate water, harm wildlife, and pollute drinking water.
